This 3,000-square-foot rooftop bar on the 30th floor of the Kimberly Hotel features ivy-covered walls, old-fashioned globe street lamps and a retractable roof that makes it possible to enjoy the 360-degree views year-round. It's best experienced at night, when the web of lightbulbs above the terrace gives a sparkling ambiance in which to appreciate the view of the Chrysler Building. In addition to signature cocktails (\$18), drinkers can choose from a selection of bottled beer and wines. Booze-friendly foods include grilled calamari (\$16) and crispy baby artichokes (\$15).
